The workshop is open to adults who enjoy photography and would like to explore photographic storytelling through observing Stoupa, its people and contemporary life.

No previous knowledge or experience in photography is required. All that is needed is an interest in photography and a willingness to take part in the creative process. Participants will use their own camera or mobile phone.

The workshop will be conducted in Greek, with support in English where needed.

Participation is **free of charge**, with a maximum of **15 participants**. Places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

The workshop is the first phase of a broader photographic project. Following the session on 25 September, participants will continue their photographic exploration throughout the festival, focusing on **“Stoupa Today”**, and will be invited to submit a selection of their photographs.

Selected works will be presented in Kardamyli as part of the **3rd Kardamili Art Doc Festival**, from 1 to 4 October 2026.
